

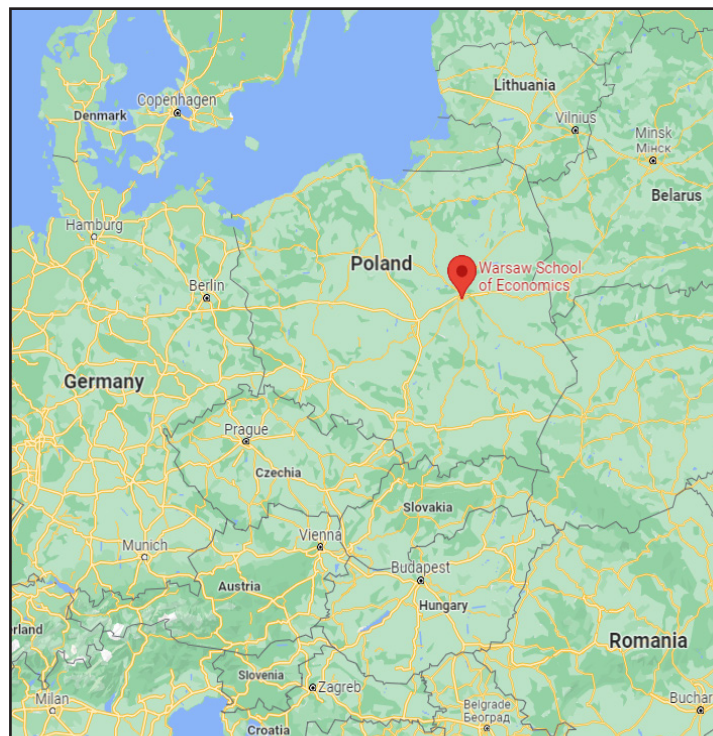

## ACCOMMODATIONS

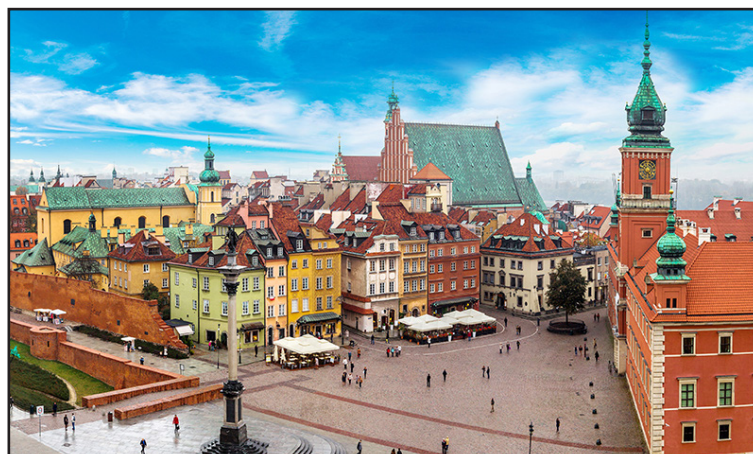
<b>Type of Accommodation:</b>	On Campus Residence or Off Campus Housing
<b>Website:</b>	<a href="#">Link</a>
<b>Cost:</b>	2000 PLN for entire semester (September to February). (Equivalent to approximately \$650 CAD)
<b>Details:</b>	SGH offers one residence building on campus, called the <a href="#">Sabinki dorm</a> . It is located in the middle of green district of Mokotow, and is a five-minute walking distance from SGH's campus. Space is limited, so exchange students are encouraged to apply early. Exchange students not offered on-campus housing must find private accommodation on their own. SGH provides the following <a href="#">resources</a> to assist.

## OTHER COSTS

<b>Health Insurance:</b>	All StFX students are required to purchase travel health insurance for the duration of their time abroad which covers trip cancellation or interruption and emergency medical care (hospitalization, medical and paramedical expenses, medical evacuation, and repatriation). <a href="#">Link</a> Additionally, SGH requires students to apply for general medical care insurance at the NFZ. The cost is 46,80 PLN (\$15 CAD) per month and entitles you to free medical care on the same basis as Polish citizens.
<b>Living Expenses:</b>	<a href="#">Link</a>
<b>Visa:</b>	Canadian citizens who wish to study in Poland must obtain a student visa valid for the entire duration of their stay. Students will also need to apply for a <a href="#">temporary residence permit</a> after arrival. The total cost is 390 PLN (\$125 CAD). <a href="#">Link</a>
