## Action to Date

Since April, the full Advisory Committee has met four times to identify key priorities and two subcommittees have been formed to further the work. These subcommittees are in the process of gathering information on existing equity and safe sport practices within StFX Athletics, with a focus on areas where structural and cultural changes are needed.



• **Equitable Resourcing** chaired by Dr. Charlene Weaving. Working group membership includes: Monica Foster, Leo MacPherson, Gary Waterman, Wendy Langley and Akwaima Akpan. Two meetings since June.

Focusing on:

- (1) Hiring and recruitment practices (i.e. Head Women Coaches)
- (2) Resource Allocation
- (3) Scheduling and Facility Bookings
- (4) Promotional Materials
- (5) Hall of Fame
  - **Safe Sport** chaired by Dr Greg Hadley. Working group membership includes: Elizabeth Yeo, Krista McKenna, Gatluak James and Matt Spencer. Three meetings since June.

Focusing on:

- 1) Document review (e.g., team data, existing athletics policies, wider university policies)
- 2) Landscape survey (connecting with other USport institutions)

3) Developing guidelines for student support staff (e.g., managers)

Upcoming work will include exploration and development of a reporting mechanism for studentathletes and advancing athletics-related recommendations from the Sexual Violence Report.

The committees will provide regular updates as their work progresses; regular reports will be shared to the campus community.
